Norm Coleman resides in El Granada, had a portrait studio in San Mateo for 25 years, and is an actor performing in local theatres. He is an authority on baseball great Ty Cobb so he informs his audience about Ty Cobb in the form of a 3-act play by portraying Cobb in a narration beginning in mid July 1961 Atlanta, Georgia. His narration was accompanied with appropriate music such as, "Take Me Out To the Ball Game." Cobb lived from December 18, 1886 to July 17, 1961. He played center and right fields for the Detroit Tgers from 1905 to 1926. He was a player/manager for the Tgers 1921 - 1926 and Philadelphia Athletics 1927 - 28. The Greatness Of Cobb included First player elected to Baseball Hall of Fame - 1936, Lifetime batting average of 367, highest in baseball history, Owner of a record 12 batting titles, Scored a major-league record of 2,245 runs, American League career hit leader with 4,191, Stole 894 bases, including 55 thefts of home.
