Lion Tail Twister Bob Fenech was called on to lead the introductions. There were 8 members present plus our two guests from Teen Challenge.

New Budget

Lion Al Gentile introduced our two guest speakers from Teen Challenge, Ron Jett and Jason McCullough.

Ron Jett is currently the Director in San Francisco. He has been with them since going through their program as a meth addict in 1996. He gave a brief history of Teen Challenge. They started in 1958, and have been in the City since 1964. There are currently 500 centers in the U.S. and 1000 worldwide. The S.F. center is for men only, 18 and older, and takes a cold-turkey approach to drug rehab. There are currently 8 men in the San Francisco program.

Jason McCullough came to the program after being a heroin addict for 17 years in February of this year. He had tried other programs, with no success. He gave a powerful talk about the program.
