The date has been decided - February 8th. The price will be \$65.00 per person, same as last year.

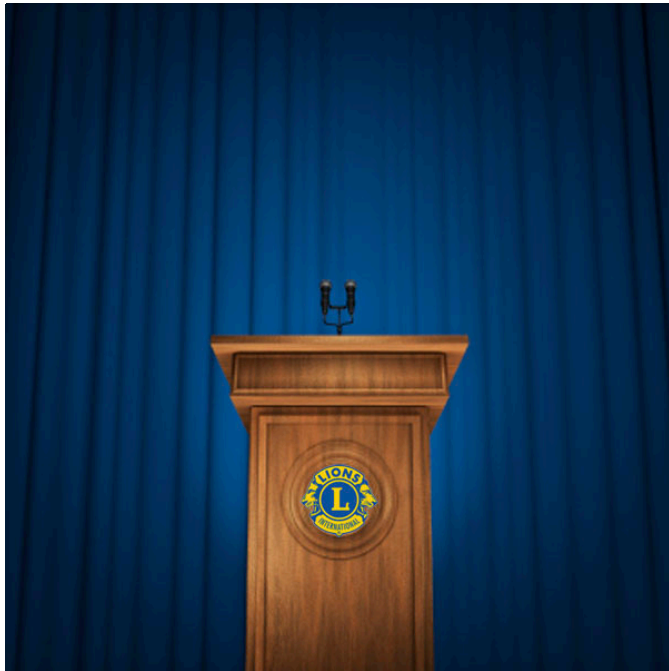
