Celebrating Lion Handford Clews

Monday, February 1st, early in the evening, Margot called letting us know that Lion Handford Clews had passed away that afternoon. Thus ended his Lions career that lasted a couple of days past 44 years.

Lion Handford joined our club on January 29, 1977 and was sponsored by Lion Frank Ferrera. He was with Arc Electric at the time as Manager of Electrical Supply.

Lion Handford's first chairmanship was for the Calendar Project, a fundraiser only remembered by our oldest members. From there, he climbed the chairs and ranks of club officers until he became President in 1982-83. He continued serving as various chairs until he landed as Treasurer in 1987-88 where he served continuously until June 2017 when he was forced to step down due to poor health.

Lion Handford received too many certificates and awards along the way to be listed here. He achieved 21 years of perfect attendance as of the 1997-98 year, the last recorded in our club records. His record of perfect attendance continued on from there with many more years added to his record.

Lion Handford sponsored 10 new members during his time: Jerome Ennis, Ed Morey, John Madden, Howard Pearson, Dick Johnson, Les Doran, Larry Ferrell, Ted Wildenradt, Sheriar Irani, and Margine Sako. He received his Membership Key in May 1982. He should have also received the Membership Advancement Key, and Builder Key, but they were not recorded in his record.

Lion Handford has served us, and the community, extremely well. Help keep his spirit alive by doing the same. For the older members who had the privilege of knowing him for years, you know how well he loved and cared for this Club, and feel the deep since of loss that is shared by each of us. Rest in peace Lion Handford.
