Celebrating Lion Al Gentile

We are greatly saddened to announce the passing of Lion Past President Al Gentile on March 8th. His passing will leave a huge hole in our club that will be very difficult to fill.

Lion Al joined our club on May 1, 1957 and was sponsored by Lion Joe Kearn. He worked as an Account Executive with New York Life at the time, and stayed with them his whole working life.

Lion Al's service to our club includes: President (1975-76), 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Vice Presidents, Secretary (3 terms), Financial Secretary (8 terms), Tail Twister (5 terms), Director (at least 8 terms), and Membership Chairman (too many terms to count).

Lion Al's chairmanships include 42+ terms on at least 12 committees. Needless to say he knew just about all the business our club did over the years.

On participation in events, and everything else for that matter, almost no member surpassed him.

Lion Al has served us, and the community, extremely well. Help keep his spirit alive by doing the same. For the older members who had the privilege of knowing him for years, you know how well he loved and cared for this Club, and feel the deep sense of loss that is shared by each of us. Rest in peace Lion Al.

The members of the Geneva-Excelsior Lions Club send our deepest condolences out to Roxanne, his daughter. Service details are not available yet.

From Roxanne Gentile:

"There is a lot of info in my dad's obit about a lot of different things. This is what we put together about his contributions to the Lions: Al's commitment as a Geneva Excelsior Lion as a long-serving member in District 4C4 lasted 65 years. He formed lifelong friendships among the members, and was a charter organizer of the annual Lions Club Crab Feed, a community fundraiser celebrated by hundreds of supporters since 1983.

I just can't express how important you and the Lions Club have been to my dad and to me and my friends. I was diagnosed with MS in early 2018 and my neuroopthomologist was at the San Francisco Eye Institute at 711 Van Ness. I received treatment at the clinic that the Lions support! I brought my dad there to see it - he found it interesting and comforting, and talk about full circle!

I will keep you posted on any upcoming developments including his burial which will be semi-private.
