Games covered will begin tomorrow, September 11. Winners will be announced in future editions. Several players have taken their spots, but have not sent in their fees. To be followed up on.

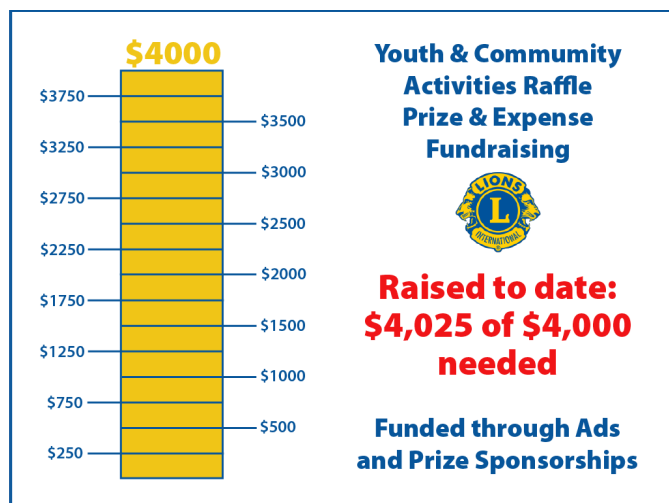


Lions Youth & Community Activities Raffle
