## **Guest Speaker**

Christian Canovas with SF-Marin Food Bank was our guest speaker, and covered:

- The Bank has 250 employees, plus about 250 volunteers per day.
- Each \$1 received is turned into 2 meals.
- Value received: 5X return on donations.
- Helps feed 10,000-20,000 people per day around the City.
- Homeless account for about 15% of those served.
- It's easy to sign up for service; there are over 300 locations in San Francisco.
- Service is balanced per location with what those served want.
- Question asked: How can we donate fruit grown in our yards? Bring it to the bank.
- It was noted that some people sell what is given to them.
- They receive 10-15 trucks per day.
- The Bank was started in the 1990s in a parking lot.
