Meeting Digest 4-16-25

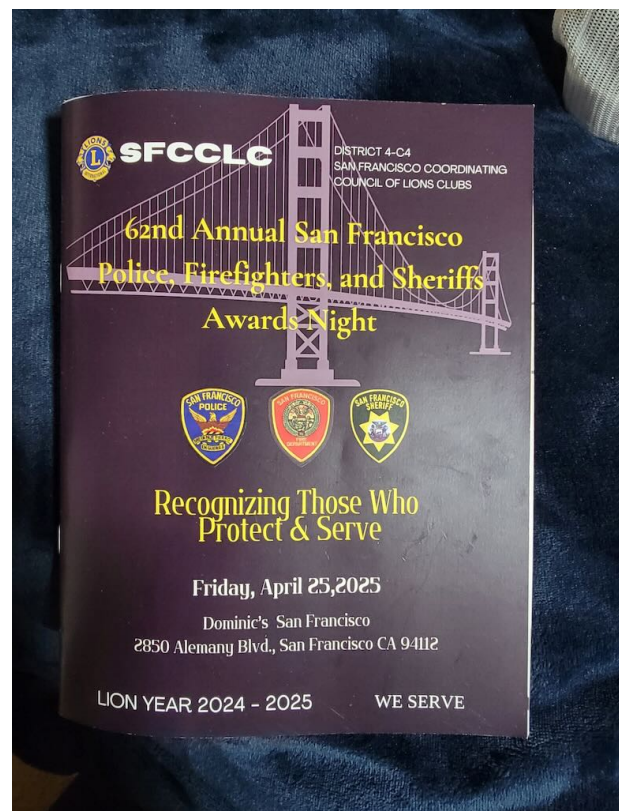
