# **C & B and Standing Rules Changes**

Discussed and approved by all present and to be sent to all members for a vote:

- Constitution & Bylaws change:
   Change definition of a quorum for Board meetings to 3 board members being present to establish a quorum. Requires 2/3 vote of all members to pass.
- Standing Rules change: Increase
   Entrance Fee from \$50 to \$75 to
   account for increased costs. Requires
   simple majority vote to pass.
