Things that happen behind the scenes that no one knows about:

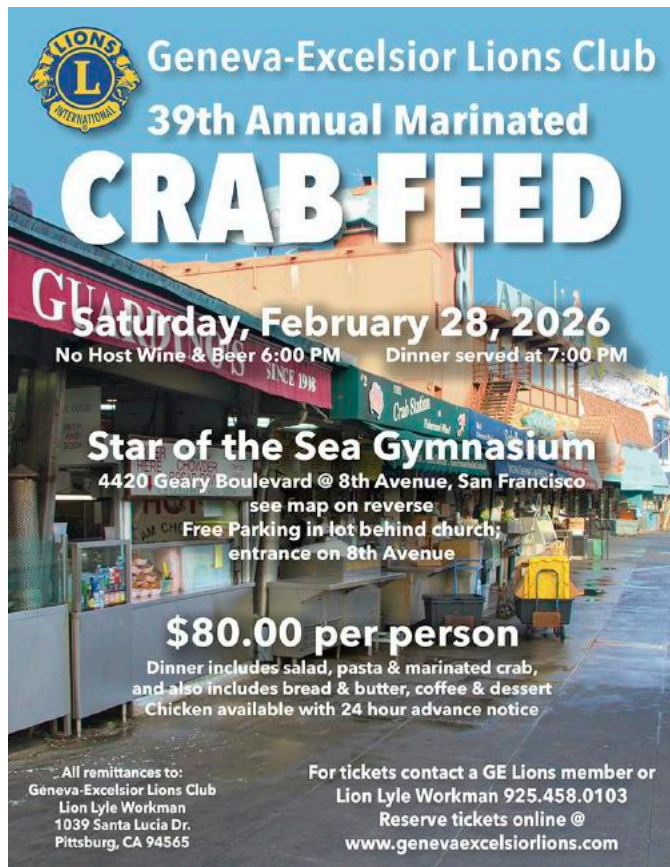
- The Nonprofit Raffle Report CT-NRP-2 was filed this month - an annual report detailing what we made on the raffle and where the money goes.
